MOODLE INTRODUCTION

Moodle is an open source e-learning software or learning management system (LMS) widely used by educators around the world. With moodle it is easy to create a dynamic course website or to create effective online learning communities. Moodle is very popular among learning institutions because it is designed based on a sound pedagogical principle that encourages students to construct knowledge through sharing, discussions and collaboration.

This short course is open to participants from higher learning institutions, schools, or colleges who want to implement e-learning to supplement the conventional teaching modes or to develop totally online training programmes. This course is offered in two modules, the first module (Instructor Module) is meant for teachers and lecturers who want to learn how to use the software to create their course websites, upload their teaching materials and to engage their students with online learning activities. The second module (Administrator Module) is meant for system administrators who want to install and manage moodle software on their own servers.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

After completing this course, participants should be able to:

- ✔ Create dynamic course websites using moodle
- ✔ Engage students with online learning activities in the moodle environment
- ✔ Install and manage moodle software on your own server
- ✔ Manage courses and users in your institution's moodle system

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The Instructor Module is designed for teachers or lecturers who wish to learn the basics of moodle and to acquire the skills on how to effectively use moodle to engage their students whether in a blended mode of teaching or in fully online courses. The Administrator Module is designed for system administrators who want to install and manage the system on their own server. It also teaches participants on how to manage moodle courses and users and to optimize the server's resources for small as well as large scale installations.
